INTRODUCTION:

As a member of our ministry staff, the worship minister will apply Spiritual gifts and skills to help CCC fulfill its vision – Love God. Love people. Serve both.

The primary focus of this position is worship leadership. Key responsibilities will be to serve as developer, coach and administrator of the music and other worship arts components over the entire worship ministry of the church for all age groups, and the ongoing use and development of technology as it applies to worship settings and the church's presence online.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Strive for excellence in our corporate worship times

- Identify, recruit, and develop leaders, instrumentalists, and vocalists for weekend worship teams. Provide guidance and direction in their service and periodic feedback about their service.
- Schedule singers and instrumentalists on a regular rotation.
- plan and provide music in advance.
- conduct mid-week rehearsal and a Sunday morning walk-through.
- Coordinate worship planning with senior minister.
- Recruit, manage, train, and schedule a volunteer team of sound technicians, video operators, streaming operators, and light operators.
- Implement creative and effective ways to share important announcements on Sunday mornings.
- Prepare video and presentation media to be used in singing and other features of corporate worship.
- To regularly be a leading presence of our corporate worship times, providing clear direction and leadership from the stage to encourage worship in spirit and in truth. This person will be CCC's "Lead Worshiper," making clear to all how to participate in the business of praise to God.
- Champion worship throughout the church family, especially as it relates to music and arts.
- Maintain church-wide compliance with media copyright laws and licensing.
- Ensure the availability of adequate equipment and instruments for all worship ministries.
- Continually expand the array of music and worship arrangements, to incorporate music both old and new that has lasting value.
- Organize special worship events, such as Good Friday and Christmas Eve.
- Form and lead a worship planning team that meets regularly to generate planning and creative ideas to enhance worship times – drama, video, special music, etc.
- Put gifts and experience to use as a teacher and resource person for the church family.
